EQUIPMENT

None needed. We will supply you with trowels or planters.

Important to bring: Hats, sunscreen, rain jackets, gum boots, garden gloves and drinking water.

Be prepared for wet weather as the show goes on regardless of the weather. Rubber boots are recommended, if not well oiled boots. If you are wearing sandals bring a couple of plastic bags to put over them or bring a change of footwear. With kids, a change of clothes may be appropriate. A pair of garden gloves (even dish washing gloves are good) are optional but they do keep your hands clean and dry. If you have a small shovel or mattock, please bring it along.

DIRECTIONS

From the Roe Hwy in Midland go up Great Eastern Highway towards Northam. At Mundaring traffic lights turn left into Stoneville road and travel approximately 8 kms towards Toodyay road. Turn right into Barkala Way after Anketell rd. Travel 665 metres until you reach our house 665, Barkala Way. We share a drive with 655 Barkala Way so keep going past this house on your left until you come to a farm gate. There is a button to press and the gate will open automatically and close behind you. Park at the front of the house and the reserve is a short walk from there, but one of the group members will meet you. **Please only park on Stoneville Rd or Barkala Way or on the property, but do not drive further onto the reserve, Tracks are only for horses and walkers and the risk of die-back is too great for the reserve.**
